In collaboration with PakArab Fertilizers, Hunar Foundation has set up another Technical Training Institute in Multan which started operations in January, 2017. The PakArab Technical Training Institute stretches over 2 acres of land and is housed on the premises of the PakArab fertilizer plant with over 100 students enrolled currently.

Initial trades offered include 6-month courses in Mechanical Manufacturing and Electrical and Electronics Technology. PakArab Fertilizer Ltd. and THF have also provided numerous scholarships and monthly benefits to deserving and committed candidates for the technical courses provided. Hunar aims to incorporate additional trades for the institute by mid-2018.

In August 2011, the Kumar family was amongst the 5 million people who were affected by the devastating floods that hit many impoverished areas of Sindh. The Kumars lost their home, all their possessions and income. Desperate to improve the family livelihood Sajjan, the eldest son, decided to join THF Hajiani Ashraf Khatoon Technical Institute (HAKTI) in Tando Allahyar, after seeing its advertisement.

Sajan Kumars education was sponsored by United Energy Pakistan (UEP) and after his graduation in December 2013 Sajjan worked at HAKTI, first as an IT Lab assistant and later as an Assistant Administrator till he

joined UEP in 2015 at the Naimat Basal field, where he is still employed as a Field Production Trainee.

“Because of Hunar I am working in a prominent industry. The quality of my work is because I received training from professional trainers and this has helped me in my work at UEP.”

Today, 25 year old Sajjan is the sole supporter of his household. He contributed towards the weddings of his three sisters and supported his younger brother’s education who recently completed his intermediate exams.

JOINING HANDS WITH NOWPDP



“The vision of Hunar Foundation is to see ‘A Skilled Pakistan’, we take great pains to provide technical training to young men and women from lesser privileged areas of the country and have them certified.

Another aim is to make them into well rounded individuals by teaching them Life skills, English and computer skills, and preparing them for interviews. Partnering with Network of Organizations Working with People with Disabilities in Pakistan, in this one of a kind initiative has added an extra dimension by providing vocational training to young men with disabilities and we can't be more proud of that fact,” CEO The Hunar Foundation.

In Pakistan, a vast majority of

persons with disabilities are at a disadvantage in the educational arena. In an effort to solve this issue, in July 2016, NOWPDP partnered with THF to provide certified training to adults with disabilities.

Staff was sensitized to ensure an inclusive training environment by the cooperation of all those involved. Over the course of the training, not only are 7 students with hearing impairment being equipped with certified market relevant skills but are also being imparted with IT and life skills to aid their personal and

professional development.

The journey has been an incredible one evident in the confidence and motivation the trainees carry as compared to the beginning of the training. Good academic performance shown by 5 of the trainees, who are appeared for the UK City & Guilds examination in June 2017, is proof of the fact that partnerships such as these can do wonders in transforming lives of young talented physically challenged individuals.

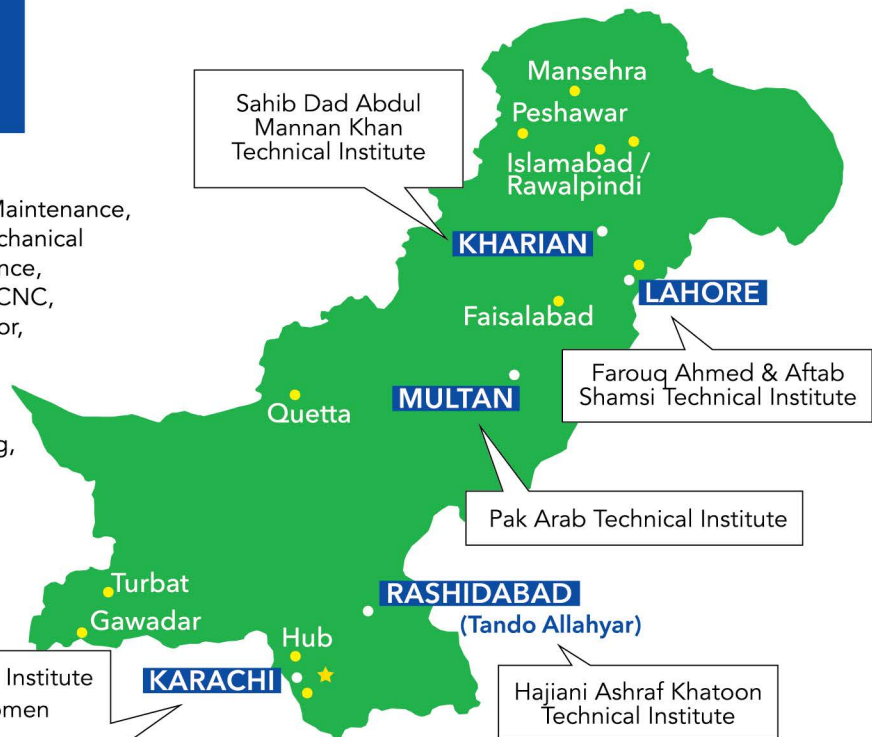

TRIP TO KUNAR PLANT IN TANDO JAM, SINDH

Trainees and staff members belonging to the Rashidabad Campus (HAKTI) visited the OGDCL Kunar Plant Tando Jam to gain insight into the industrial atmosphere they would be part of in the near future.

OGDCL is a partner of Hunar Foundation, having supported the education and hostel arrangements of 69 students at HAKTI.

Mr. Fayaz, the field manager at the plant, welcomed all trainees warmly and showed them around the plant.

The visit commenced with Mr. Aziz-ur-Rehman briefing the trainees on the importance of safety and health requirements after which they were presented with Personal Protective Equipment (PPEs). Following, the trainees surveyed the mechanical and electrical processes present throughout the plant with a rundown on how techniques and systems operated.

The students were provided with maximum safety and security and the sessions were conducted with utmost ease and expertise. The sessions concluded with a small refreshment session.

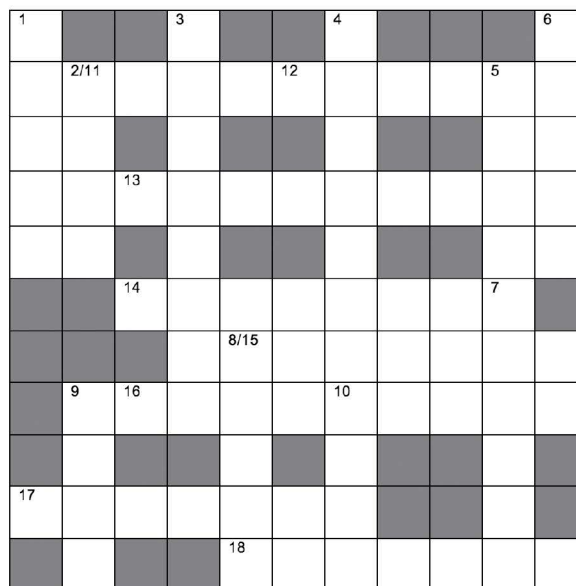
