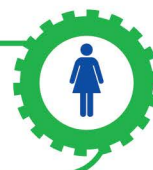

40-YEAR-OLD ATIYA MUBASHIR'S LIFE CAME TO A TRAUMATIC STANDSTILL WHEN SHE LOST HER HUSBAND IN THE 2013 TWIN BOMB BLASTS IN ABBAS TOWN, KARACHI.

Grief stricken, Atiya alone had to look after her two children, a girl who was 12 and a 10-year-old boy. Atiya lifted herself up and taught at a local school for a meager salary that was not enough to run the household. Looking for further sources of income, she started providing basic beauty services from home. Not a trained beautician, she could not get many clients.

In 2017 Atiya heard about The Hunar Foundation's Central Vocational Institute (CVI) for women and enrolled in the Beauty Therapy course. Through THF, she acquired knowledge and On-Job-Training in a major salon in Karachi.

Soon after graduation, Atiya secured a job at Zaitoon Salon where she is now earning a stable income. In her spare time, she also provides salon services from her home.

THF is proud of how Atiya has evolved into a confident woman who has not only battled her trauma symptoms but is also no longer fearful of the future.
